The best practices for growing high quality plants for food and medicine require the balancing of three disciplines:

- ☞ Morphology: the study of plant forms creates a foundation for understanding the ever-changing inner chemistry of plant hormones.
- ☞ Plant Physiology: understanding the physical, chemical and biological functioning of plants
- ☞ Phenology: provides the skillful use of planetary movements to optimize work rhythms.

This new offering looks at the practical application of these disciplines as they appear in the course of a grower's year. Designed for serious gardeners as well as the commercial grower, each session will involve plant study, alchemical methodologies, and planetary rhythm influences that when integrated improve dramatically the quality of cultivated plants.

Topics in each session include: Plant family structures; sowing, cultivation, & harvest strategies for annuals and perennials; creating organic hormonal ferments for plant sprays; calendar work; plant and mineral relationships; alchemical philosophy; and laboratory practice.
